One-Year Term Contract with Four Years of Renewal Options for Magnesium Subject:

Anodes for the Materials and Supply Warehouse (for the Energy Resources

Department) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Business Services and Energy Resources Departments and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, International Corrosion Control, Inc. at \$116,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Producer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide 1 lb. and 32 lb. magnesium anodes per specifications for use in the City's natural gas distribution system. Anodes protect against galvanic corrosion of steel pipe. These anodes will be used by Gas Utility for new construction projects and the maintenance and repair of existing utilities. Materials and Supply place orders and maintains inventory as needed.
