**Subject:** Use of a Cooperative Contract for the Purchase of a Forklift (Addition) for the

Transportation Department (Citywide)

#### **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Transportation Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Arnold Machinery for \$38,417.16.

### **Background / Discussion**

Transportation is requesting a forklift for use at the East Mesa Service Center. They currently borrow one from either Fleet Services or the Warehouse. Demand for the use of a forklift by all three areas has significantly increased. It would be beneficial to add one to Transportation's fleet.

The State of Arizona cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. Fleet Services, Transportation, and Purchasing believe this contract is advantageous to the City and pricing is fair and reasonable.
