| Subject: | Purchase of One (1) Gas Chromatograph Mass Spectrometer (GC/MS) (Replacement) for the Mesa Police Department (Citywide) |

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Police Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the sole source vendor, KPrime Technologies, Inc. at \$145,000, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide a Gas Chromatograph Mass Spectrometer (GC/MS) and Agilent Quickprobe for the Forensic Services Controlled Substances Unit. The GC/MS has the capacity for full range of testing related to any evidence submitted to the lab that may contain a controlled substance or prescription drug.

The Agilent GC/MS was selected for the following reasons:

- The Controlled Substances Unit already has three Agilent GC/MS systems. No additional instrument validation will be required to implement this new instrument.
- Parts and consumables for this system are interchangeable with the current GC/MS used in the Unit.
- The Forensic scientists are already familiar with the software platform used to acquire and generate reports in a very short timeframe and no additional software/training/validation will be required.
- Yearly maintenance service for the entire lab can be performed by one factory authorized vendor.
- Historically, Agilent products provide superior services, and the products have a long service history.

KPrime Technologies, Inc. is the authorized manufacturer's representative for Agilent in Arizona.
