Subject: Purchase of Stage Lighting Fixtures (Replacements) for the Mesa Arts Center, Ikeda and Playhouse Theaters, as requested by the Arts and Culture Department (Citywide)

## Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.
The Arts and Culture Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, Barbizon Light of the Rockies at \$198,246.54.

## Background / Discussion

This purchase is for the replacement of stage lighting equipment for the Ikeda and Playhouse Theaters. This will begin the phased replacement and upgrade of the most commonly used lighting fixtures and components to LED technology. In addition to the increased capability of the stage lighting, the replacements will significantly lower the power consumption from an average of 750 watts to 300 watts per fixture.

The City has established both a brand name-only specification for specific items in addition to like or equivalent for other items. Demos were completed to ensure that items marked as brand name only, interfaced with existing lighting systems and components.
