Subject: Use of a Cooperative Contract for an Initial Term of 18-Months and Three

Years of Renewal Options for Machine Shop and Related Services for the

Water Resources Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Water Resources Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the City of Phoenix cooperative contract with Device Development, LLC at \$300,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide machine shop and related services as needed for the City's reclamation and water treatment plants. Services include but are not limited to blueprint and/or drawing preparation, disassembly and assembly services, precision machining, machinery and equipment services, fabrication, field services, welding, inspection, and quality control.

The City of Phoenix cooperative contract will allow the Water Resources Department to address immediate needs in maintaining and/or rebuilding pumps, motors, and other large industrial machinery. Additionally, the vendor can fabricate replacement parts for older equipment, where ordering new OEM parts is no longer feasible. The Phoenix cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets City procurement requirements.
