**Subject:** One-Year Term Contract with One-Year Renewal Options for Compressed

Natural Gas (CNG) Station Operation and Maintenance Services for the Solid

Waste Department (Citywide)

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Solid Waste Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Strategic Alliance for Volume Expenditures (S.A.V.E.)/City of Scottsdale cooperative contract with Clean Energy dba Clean Energy Fuels Corp. at \$235,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

## **Background / Discussion**

This contract will provide CNG station maintenance and repair services; an all-inclusive, maintenance service program to keep the City's CNG stations operating at its optimal level. Clean Energy has been delivering these comprehensive maintenance services to the City of Scottsdale since 2012, making them uniquely qualified and prepared to meet the City of Mesa's scope of work requirements.

The City of Scottsdale cooperative contract for CNG Station Maintenance is new. This contract has been competitively bid and meets the City of Mesa's procurement requirements. City of Scottsdale, along with Tucson and other cities in Arizona, used a prior contract with Clean Energy to maintain their CNG Stations at competitive prices. CNG station operation and maintenance are critical to the City's solid waste operations.
