Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Water-Reducible Alkyd Paint for the Solid Waste Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Solid Waste Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, Bert's Paint, Inc. at \$37,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Producer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The Solid Waste Department uses water-reducible alkyd gloss paint to paint the City's trash and recycle bins and roll-off containers via spray application and/or roller application. Staff estimates approximately 1,000 gallons of paint will be applied using a standard electric airless paint sprayer and approximately 100 gallons will be applied by roller annually.
