Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Business Services and Transportation Departments and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, Canuck Power Inc. at \$39,100 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Producer Price Index.

This contract will provide traffic signposts (galvanized metal posts, signs, rivets, and anchors) for the Transportation Department. The materials are for the installation, replacement, and/or relocation of traffic control and street name signs throughout the City. Materials and Supply places orders and maintains stock inventory as needed.
