Subject:	Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Deceased Animal Collection Services for the Community Services Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Community Services Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, AquaCrossings at \$142,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide a Contractor for deceased animal pickup and proper disposal of the animal (up to 150 lbs. each) that are reported within the incorporated limits of the City by cremation or other means in accordance with the standards and methods approved by the Maricopa County Health Department.

The estimated number of calls for deceased animal collection service included (12) special pickups in 2018, (20) in 2019, (15) in 2020, (18) in 2021, and (29) in 2022. Calls for service included 840 in 2018, 813 in 2019, 828 in 2020, 848 in 2021, and 833 in 2022.

The contract requires the Contractor to possess a valid medical waste haulers permit from Maricopa County Environmental Services Department and an ADEQ (Arizona Department of Environmental Quality) Biohazardous Medical Waste Transport License.
