Subject: Three-Year Term Contract for Randox Drug Screening and Testing Supplies for the Mesa Police Department **(Sole Source) (Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Police Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the sole source vendor, Randox Toxicology Limited at \$150,000 annually, based on estimated usage.

Background / Discussion

On 9/9/2013, Council approved the purchase of one Randox Evidence Investigator Biochip Analyzer. The system saves time and labor spent on individual tests as it allows for multiple tests to be conducted from a single patient sample.

This contract will provide Randox Evidence Investigator biochip kits for drug testing for Mesa's Forensic Services Laboratory.

Randox Toxicology is the sole manufacturer and supplier of the Biochip Array Technology-based Evidence Investigator analyzer, multiplex biochip technology. The associated reagents are also exclusively manufactured and distributed by Randox and are only available from Randox.
