SS4A Program

- Part of the federal Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
 - Established a wide range of programs aimed at improving the nation's infrastructure
- Safe Streets and Roads for All Program
 - Focused on improving roadway safety and reducing serious injuries and fatalities to those who walk, bike, roll and travel in a vehicle.
 - \$5 Billion in funding over the next 5 years
 - Two types of grants
 - Action Plan Grants Planning document
 - Implementation Grants Implement strategies from an Action Plan








Mesa Action Plan Submittal

- August 2022 Proclamation by Mayor Giles
- September 2022 SS4A Submittal
- **February 2023** Mesa notified that we were awarded an Action Plan Grant
 - o Federal Grant Funding \$750,000
 - o City of Mesa Local Match \$187,500

These awards include 474 Action Plan Grants and 37 Implementation Grants, shown in the map below.







Schedule

- Summer 2023 Finalize grant agreement with Federal Highway Administration
- Fall 2023 Procure consultant through RFQ process
- Winter 2023 Action Plan kick-off
- Winter 2024 Completion of Action Plan
- **Spring 2025** Apply for SS4A Implementation Grant
