Subject: Purchase of Additional and Upgraded Wireless Network Analysis and

Security Tools for the Information Technology Department (Citywide)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the Purchase of Additional and Upgraded Wireless Network Analysis and Security Tools as recommended.

The Information Technology Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase from the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, PacketLogix Inc. at \$87,618.23.

Background / Discussion

The City has a significant investment in Wi-Fi infrastructure, providing this to many municipally-owned facilities as well as providing public Wi-Fi. As the City expands our wireless service the border of our network expands which in turn increases the area of our network that needs to be protected.

This purchase will provide WiFi Network Analysis and Security Tools to allow the City to monitor wireless traffic between our access points and the exterior switches leading into our internal network.

This is the first Phase of three Phases, to either implement sensors in locations where they do not exist, replace aging sensors that are limited in what frequency bands they can monitor or rogue services they can detect.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize purchase and a new bid will be solicited.

Funding for this purchase is available in the Information Technology Department budget through the Lifecycle Program -- Infrastructure budget.
