JT Food Services, LLC (applicant)
To Whom IMay Concern:
These comments are provided as background on the above-referenced liquor license application. The applicant, JT Food Services, LLC ("JT Food Services") is seeking a new Series 12 liquor license for its restaurant located at 1055 N. Dobson Road, Suite 106. Mesa, AZ. The sole member of JT Food Services is Taek Nam ("NAM"). The name of the proposed restaurant is Makitto Sushi.

According to the Corporation Commission, the only member of JT Food Services is NAM. Nevertheless, the liquor application indicates that the restaurant will employ two sushi chefs. Social media advertising the opening of the Makitta restaurant identifies these two sushi chefs as (J)ay Chung and (T)aek Nam.

## A LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THIS RESTAURANT WILL ENDANGER THE COMMUNITY

A licensee or an employee of a licensee that becomes intoxicated while working in an establishment that holds a liquor license is violating the law. An employee who takes even one drink while serving alcoholic beverages in retail establishment that serves liquor is also a state-law violation. A.R.S. \$4-244(13).

The liquor license application at issue indicates that NAM worked as a sushi chef for four months at the SUSHI J restaurant in Scotsdale and for two months at the J's KAIYO restaurant, also in Scottsdale. NAM worked at both of these restaurants alongside his more experienced brother-in-law, Jay Chung ("CHUNG").

Both NAM AND CHUNG were fired from J's KAIYO at the same time. CHUNG apparently has a drinking problem and it didn't take long for J's KAIYO to realize that CHUNG's drinking problem was a a severe problem. The general manager at J's KAIYO has described CHUNG as a "psycho drunk."

CHUNG was convicted of Extreme DUI in 2016 following his arrest after leaving work from the SUSHI J restaurant in the early moming hours by the Gilbert police department. According to the police report, CHUNG tried to justify his inebriation to the arresting officer by claiming that drinking on the job was a cultural thing for sushi chefs:
"I'm a sushi chef, it is part of the culture to drink while working, like tonight"

CHUNG had also been fired for drinking on the job by two previous employers. After being fired for drinking on the job at the Sakana and Otaku restaurants in Scottsdale, CHUNG and his partner Maggie Liao ("LlAO") opened the SUSHI J restaurant; however, CHUNG continued to drink on the job as he had done before.

The restaurant and the liquor license were held in the name of J\&M Food Services, LLC ("J\&M") When LIAO objected to his drinking on the job at that restaurant, CHUNG created other entities in the hopes of moving to yet another restaurant

Despite lease negotiations, neither of these two entities actually opened a new restaurant. The J's KAIYO restaurant that CHUNG had hoped to own was opened in March, 21017, and is being operated by an entity named PJ Food Services, LLC that is apparently owned solely by Pajman Malihi, ("MALIHI"), a convicted felon.

On February 8, 2017, CHUNG resigned as an owner of SUSHI J and, together with NAM and two others, loaded up three pickup trucks full of restaurant equipment and supplies taken from the SUSHI J restaurant, together with seafood and $\$ 500$ worth of McCallan scotch that had just been delivered to that afternoon -- taking these three truckloads to MALIHI's home.

The following morning, MALIHI's attorneys delivered a notice signed by CHUNG, indicating that CHUNG had withdrawn as a member of J\&M prior to closing the business on the previous day, leaving the restaurant premises, the business entity, and all of the restaurant debt left behind by CHUNG in the hands of LIAO. When LIAO was finally able to access the Sushi J premises, it was apparent that virtually no food (and none of the liquor) remained on the premises. In addition to the food and beverages, essential restaurant equipment needed to operate a restaurant, including menus, uniforms, and the restaurant's POS system were missing. Both NAM and CHUNG are now defendants in a Federal lawsuit arising out of their actions in connection with the Sushi J restaurant.

In short, if CHUNG is not in fact a silent partner in JT Food Services, it is clear that the two of them are working closely together. CHUNG has a long history of alcohol abuse and NAM has condoned, enabled, and empowered CHUNG's embezzlements and his drinking on the job. It is believed that the combination of NAM and CHUNG in an establishment that hosts a liquor license will endanger the community.

## Symopsis:

On 12/24/14 at 0246 hours, Jay Chung was arrested for DUl in the area of Alma School Rd./ Queen Creek Rd. (Chandles).

## Narrative:

On 12/24/14 at approximately 0240 hours, I was travelling south on Alma School Rd., approaching Queen Creek Rd. in my assigned, unmarked Gilbert Police vehicle (PDP2145), while participating in the East Valley DUI Task Foree, when I observed a white Honda Civic with no rear lights travelling slowly southbound on Alma School Rd. straddling the center of the number 1 and 2 lanes. As 1 positioned my vehicle behind the Honda, I observed it to be travelling 12 mph . The posted speed limit on this roadway is 45 mph . 1 also noted that the car was leaning heavily to the drivers side.

The driver was slow to respond to the red light at Queen Creek Rd. and stopped with the entire vehicle past the painted limit line, at an unusual angle to the left. Due to this angle, I was able to see that both left tires were flat and 1 observed damage to the wheels.

As the light turned green, the Honda had a delayed response of 5-6 seconds before proceeding through the intersection while performing a slow sweeping wide left turn into the number 3 lane of eastbound Queen Creek Rd., almost striking the curb with the right wheels.

I activated my emergency lights and siren to initiate a traffic stop and the vehicle abruptly accelerated and swerved to the left into the number I lane while continuing to travel east. I repositioned my vehicle behind the Honda and it slowly drifted to the right and yiclded with the front left tire resting against the curb.

I contacted the driver and sole occupant, later identified as Jay Chung with his Arizona Drivers License, and informed him of the reason for the stop. Jay seemed to be extremely disorientated and confused. While speaking to him, I noticed his eyes to be very red and watery, his speech to be seemingly heavily slurred, and could smeil the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the vehicle. I asked Jay how much alcohol he consumed prior to driving and he replied, "I'm ok. I had a lot but I'm coming from my restaurant in Scottsdale. I'm the owner."

I asked Jay to exit the vehicle, which he did on his own using the door and body of the vehicle to brace himself. He took slow and seemingly deliberate steps to a nearby sidewalk and tripped over the curb almost falling.

While outside of the vehicle, I continued to smell the strong odor of alcohol emitting from his breath in an open air environment from an approximate distance of 3 feet. Jay had an approximate $3^{\prime \prime}+$ circular sway while

attempting to stand still.
I asked Jay why he was driving with two flat tires and he replicd, "It's a long story but only one is flat and I'm a restaurant owner. That's where I was. I know Larry Fitzgerald."

At approximately 0245 hours, Jay agreed to perform a series of Field Sobriety Tests (FST's). Prior to the performance of the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) test, Jay removed his glasses. I confirmed that he was not wearing contacts and was not currently suffering from a head injury or taking prescription medications. 1 checked Jay's eyes for equal pupil size and equal tracking indicative of a head injury. I observed his pupils were the same size and eyes tracked together. I performed HGN and observed 6 clues (lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees). Vertical nystagmus was also noted. Jay continued his approximate $3+$ " circular sway during the test and had to be reinstructed multiple times to keep his head forward and still. I am currently trained and certified in the performance of the HGN test.

Due to Jay's extremely unsteadiness and him being unable to stand in one place for any length of time without almost falling, no further FST's were administered for his safety.

Jay refused completed a PBT.
Based on the odor of alcohol on Jay's breath, red, watery eyes, HGN results, physical actions, slurred speech, admissions, and driving behavior, he was arrested for DUI at 0246 hours.

While I was placing Jay into handcuffs, he attempted to pull away and yelled, "I'm a restaurant owner you can't do this."

Jay was placed on his knees, handcuffed (double locked) and secured into my patrol vehicle without further incident.

While seated in the patrol vehicle, I attempted to read Jay his Miranda Rights, but was unable to because he became argumentative. He repeatedly said "I live right here let me go" and "I am a restaurant owner."

As I was starting to transport Jay to the Gilbert PD Santan Detention center for processing, he spontaneously yelled, "I only had one flat tire." I stopped my patrol vehicle next to Jay's Honda so he could see that both his front and rear left tires were flat. His response was, "Oh shit they are."

Jay's vehicle was inventoried and towed from the scene by Tri City Towing per ARS 28-872.
During transport to the GPD Santan station, Jay rambled, incoherently at times, about multiple topics including: His sushi restaurant, divorce, children and NFL football. He repeatedly bounced back and forth between these topics and never completed a complete thought or sentence.

Upon arival to GPD Santan Detention, Jay apologized for arguing and "wasting time." At 0312 hours, 1 read him his Miranda Rights. His quoted response to understanding his rights was "Yes." At 0313 hours, I read Jay Admin Per Se/Implied Consent. Jay's quoted response to providing a blood sample was, "Yes," consenting to provide a blood sample.

At 0336 hours, I completed Jay's blood draw from his left antecubital median vein without incident. ! packaged and sealed the blood kit. Sgt. Gillis impounded the kit to be sent to the Mesa PD Lab for analysis.

Jay declined a DUI Interview, but repeatedly told me that he was the owner of "Sushi J" in Scottsdale and requested that I watch his You Tube videos to prove it.

Jay was processed and issued a criminal citation (\#337436) for:
28-1381a! DUI-Slightest Degree (M)
28-1381a2 DUI-. 08 BAC or Greater (M)
After providing Jay with a copy of the citation and his vehicle tow paperwork, Jay apologized again and said "I'm a sushi chef, its part of the culture to drink while working, like tonight."

Jay's ride got lost while enroute to the station, so I provided him with a courtesy ride to the area of Riggs/Cooper (Chandler) to meet his girlfriend.

This concludes my contact with Jay Chung.
Conclusion:
On 12/24/14 at 0246 hours, Jay Chung was arrested for DUI in the area of Alma School Rd./ Queen Creek Rd. (Chandler). Jay committed this act by operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. Based on the odor of alcohol on Jay's breath, red, watery eyes, HGN results, physical actions, slurred speech, admissions, and driving behavior, he was processed and cited into the Santan Justice Court for:

## THE DEFENDANT ENTERED A PLEA OF guilty on 05/21/2010 to Count One of the Information.

## ACCORDINGLY, THE COURT HAS ADJUDICATED THAT THE DEFENDANT IS GUILTY OF THE

 FOLLOWING OFFENSE(S): violating Title 21, U.S.C. §846, 841 (a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C), Conspiracy to Distribute 50 kilograms or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of Marijuara, a Schedule I controlled substance, a Class C Felony offense, as charged in theInformation.

IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THIS COURT THAT the defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons for a term of SIX (6) MONTHS on Count One, with credit for time served. Upon release from imprisonment, the defendant shall be placed on supervised release for a term of THREE (3) YEARS on Count One.

## CRIMINAL MONETARY PENALTIES

The defendant shall pay to the Clerk the following total criminal monetary penalties:

## SPECIAL ASSESSMENT: $\$ 100.00$ FINE: $\$ 3,000.00$ RESTITUTION: $\$ 0.00$

## AFFIDAVIT OF RICHARD V. GREENE

RICHARD V. GREENE, being first duly sworn, upon his oath deposes and says as follows:

1. I am a resident of Maricopa County, Arizona.
2. I am familiar with the Sushi I restaurant located at 4320 N. Miller Road in Oid Town Scottsdale, as my wife has worked at the restaurant. I have met and know the principal owners of the Sushi \& restaurant who were Maggie Llao and Jay Chung.
3. On February 9, 2017, I testified at a hearing in certain litigation Maggie Liao filed against Jay Chung, among others, in Superior Court. My testimony concerned what I had seen in the evening of February 8, 2017.
4. On Wednesday, February 8, 2017, at about 6:00 PM, I dropped off my wife at the TJ Maxx in the Camelback and Miller Shopping Plaza, which is where the Sushi I restaurant is located. The TJ Maxx store is just north of Sushi J.
5. I saw Jay Chung with four (4) Individuals in front of Sushi J at that time. The four (4) people with Mr. Chung were Clayton Hanley, Edson Granados, Antonio Ortiz, and Taek Gul Nam. Mr. Chung and the other people were loading boxes from inside the restaurant into three (3) trucks. I have some knowledge of the litigation between Maggie Liao and Jay Chung, so I called Ms. Liao and her attorney, James LaGanke, and both suggested that I see where Mr. Chung was taking the personal property from the restaurant.
6. I specifically saw Mr. Chung and the others take boxes from the SushiJ restaurant and load them Into the three (3) trucks. Some of the boxes were marked as contalning liquor, such as saki and other types of alcohol.
7. I watched Mr. Chung and the others untll they finished loading the trucks, then followed Mr. Chung and the trucks to a parking lot on Drinkwater Boulevard in Scottsdale where Mr. Chung met with Jacob Hippensteel, his attorney. Mr. Hippensteel was In Court when I testified on February 9, 2017, and I specifically identified him as the person with Mr. Chung on February 8, 2017, during the meetlng in the parking lot. Also, Mr. Hippensteel's office is at 4250 N. DrInkwater Boulevard. After ten or
fifteen minutes another man joined the conversation or meeting between Mr. Chung and Mr. Hippensteel. I believe that man is Kevin McCarthy, who Is also an attorney representing Mr. Chung. During that meeting, the three (3) trucks that had been loaded at the Sushi J restaurant were parked directly in front of Mr. Chung, Mr. Hippensteel, and Mr. McCarthy.
8. The meeting lasted about forty-five minutes, then Mr. Chung left in a car and the gentlemen driving the trucks followed him to a residence located in Scottsdale at Redacted
. I followed Mr. Lung and the trucks to that location where I saw the garage door open. Inside the garage was a large freezer. I saw Mr. Chung and the other gentlemen start unloading the trucks into the garage at that residence. I learned that the Redacted address is the residence of Pajman Mir Malihi.
