Subject:	Four-Year Term Contract with Renewal Options for Biochemical Oxygen Demand Analyzers for the Water Resources Department (Initial Replacement Purchase is funded by Life Cycle Replacement) (Citywide)

#### Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

A committee representing the Water Resources Department and Purchasing evaluated responses. The evaluation committee recommends awarding the contract to the highest scored proposal from Seal Analytical, Inc., Year 1 at \$40,000, Years 2, 3, and 4, at \$10,000 annually; with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

#### **Background / Discussion**

Water Resources - Compliance Laboratory utilizes a Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) system to analyze microbial, inorganic and organic samples from the City of Mesa's three wastewater reclamation plants, including the pre-treatment and stormwater programs.

The City received four proposal responses, of which three met the minimum qualifications and one was deemed was as non-responsive (LAR Process Analyzers AG). The evaluation committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the City's established policies and procedures and completed the final scoring against the scoring criteria in the solicitation. The evaluation committee recommends a four-year year contract with renewal options to the highest scored proposal from, Seal Analytical, Inc. The evaluation was conducted by and points were awarded by consensus by the evaluation committee.
