**Subject:** One Year Term Contract for Altec Equipment Service, Repairs and Parts for

the Fleet Services (Sole Source) (Citywide)

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fleet Services Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the sole source vendor, Altec Industries, Inc., at \$70,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

## **Background / Discussion**

The City of Mesa has thirteen vehicles with Altec aerial lift equipment. Aerial equipment requires annual inspections completed yearly by certified Altec technicians. The repairs that result from the inspections also must be performed by Altec certified technicians. This contract will provide service and technical support administered by Altec Industries, the industry leader in design, manufacture and support of aerial, digger derrick and specialty products.

Altec Industries, Inc. is the sole-source provider for Altec authorized repairs for Altec aerial equipment.
