A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO RECEIVE UP TO \$206,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FOR EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING FOR THE MESA FIRE AND MEDICAL DEPARTMENT'S URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE RAPID RESPONSE TEAM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving and authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to enter into a subrecipient agreement with the Arizona Department of Homeland Security, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, to accept up to \$206,000 in grant funds for equipment and training to sustain the Mesa Fire and Medical Department's Urban Area Security Initiative Rapid Response Team.

or designee of the Intergovernmental Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
