Commercial Electrical Contractor Services for the Parks Recreation and

Community Facilities Department (Citywide)

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract renewal as recommended.

The Parks Recreation and Community Facilities Department (PRCF) and Purchasing recommend authorizing the renewal with Swain Electric Inc.; Spectra Electrical Services; Kearney Electric, Inc. dba, Kearney Electric and Communications; Commonwealth Electric Company of the Midwest; Jenco, Inc. dba, Jen Electric, Jen Service, Control Engineering; and JFK Electrical Contracting Enterprises, Inc.; at \$1,200,000 annually, based on estimated usage.

## **Background / Discussion**

This contract provides a list of pre-qualified electrical contractors to perform commercial electrical maintenance and repair work on various City facilities/projects on an as-needed basis. Contractors must possess a valid State of Arizona Specialty Commercial Contractors C-11 or CR-11 license and driver's license per minimum qualifications.

The aforementioned vendors have agreed to renew the contract. Having a qualified contractors list provides PRCF the ability to competitively bid and manage projects on a larger scale. PRCF has been satisfied with each vendor's quality of work, pricing and customer service. This contract continues to be advantageous to the City and it is in the City's best interest to renew the contract.
