Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Public

Restroom Furnishings Equipment/Parts for the Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (Single Response) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

A committee representing the Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (PRCF) and Purchasing evaluated responses. The evaluation committee recommends awarding the contract to the single, responsive and responsible proposal from Partitions & Accessories (a Mesa business), at \$80,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department currently maintains 43 public restroom facilities. This contract will provide multiple brands of public restroom furnishings/equipment for routine maintenance, repair and replacement. The contract requires the contractor to provide a full range of equipment to meet the needs of the City.

This is the second solicitation the City has made for Public Restroom Furnishings, the first solicitation the City received no responses. In addition to the firms on the registered vendor lists, PRCF provided additional vendors to reach out to and Purchasing notified these vendors of the solicitation. Vendors had reasonable opportunity to respond and the City received a single response. PRCF and Purchasing recommend award to the single, qualified respondent, Partitions & Accessories. Pricing is based on a discount off of list price and appears to be fair and reasonable.
