Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Slurry Seal

Sand for the Transportation Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the single, responsive and responsible bidder, Calmat Company dba, Vulcan Materials Company at \$690,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Producer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The Transportation Department has been using slurry seal sand for over 20 years to seal Mesa's road surfaces. The sand seals, enriches weathered pavements, fills fine cracks in the pavement surface and provides additional skid resistance to the pavement while inhibiting raveling.

This contract will provide Type II and Type III slurry seal sand (per Maricopa Association of Governments specifications) for in-house Transportation crews to use as part of the Pavement Preservation plan established by the Pavement Management team. The prices are for both self-pickup and delivery to City of Mesa.

The City received two responses for Slurry Seal Sand; however, one of the responses was considered non-responsive. This resulted in Vulcan Materials being the only responsive bidder. After review of their response, the City has determined that their bid pricing is fair and reasonable and other vendors had a reasonable opportunity to respond
