Subject: Purchase of Storage Infrastructure (Upgrade/Replacement) for the Department of Innovation and Technology Department (**Funded by Department of Innovation and Technology Lifecycle Program budget**) (**Citywide**)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Department of Innovation and Technology and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Mohave cooperative contract and lowest quote vendor, iT1 Source at \$29,423.10 based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

The current storage system contains critical data used by computer applications that serve both citizens and internal City business needs. The data stored on these devices is vital to the reliable provision of City services.

The current storage system is reaching capacity and needs to be expanded to ensure continued reliable operation. The requested upgrade will add an additional 23TB of storage and will provide supportable and sustainable data storage into the future.
