Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Kimbrell Electric, Inc. at \$171,200 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide for the installation of inductive loop detectors. Inductive loops detect vehicles at signalized intersections. This contract will typically be used for maintenance purposes to replace existing detectors that are defective but may also be used for the installation of new detectors. Work includes barricade set-up, saw cutting and installation of traffic loops per specifications at various locations within the City.
