**Subject:** Purchase of Two, Mohawk TP-16 Two-Post Lifts (Replacements) for the Fleet Services Department **(Citywide)**

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fleet Services Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Mohawk Automotive Lifts S.W. at \$33,270.37, based on estimated requirements.

## Background / Discussion

The Fleet Services Department has two, in-ground lifts that have passed their 20-year service life and need to be replaced due to multiple failures. Fleet Services technicians are trained yearly on the Mohawk equipment and have numerous adapters commonly used on the lifts without duplicating tooling. Replacing the failing in-ground lifts with above ground lifts will provide a safer working environment for the technicians and mitigate the risk of ground contamination from an in-ground tank oil leak.

The State of Arizona cooperative contract has been competitively bid, meets the City's procurement requirements, and allows for cooperative use. Fleet Services and Purchasing believe that going out for a formal bid would not result in any cost savings to the City.
