## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Business Services Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidders, BROEN, Inc and Tri-Pacific Supply, Inc at \$100,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

This contract will provide weld end ball valves stocked in the Materials and Supply Warehouse for use by Energy Resources in gas construction and maintenance projects.
