2021 Emergency Rental/Utility Assistance Program

- \$15.7 million funded by the U.S. Treasury, Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021
- \$14.1 million (90%) to Mesa residents who are financially impacted by COVID to prevent eviction and homelessness
- 10% for program administration
