CIVILIAN PARAMEDIC - \$80,000 + \$40,000 (ONE-TIME)

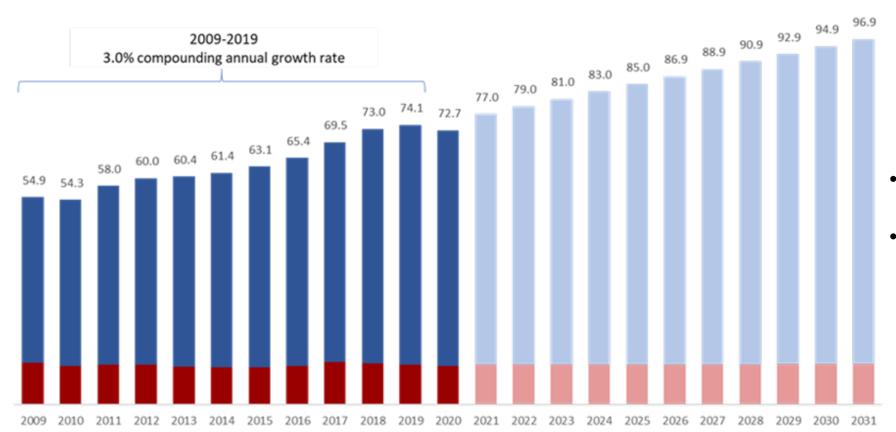
PROGRAM ASSISTANT @ STAFFING - \$72,000 + \$7,000 (ONE-TIME)

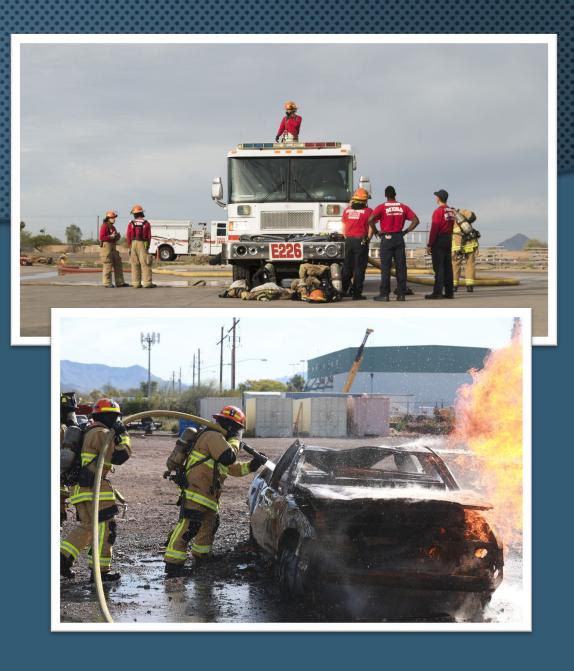

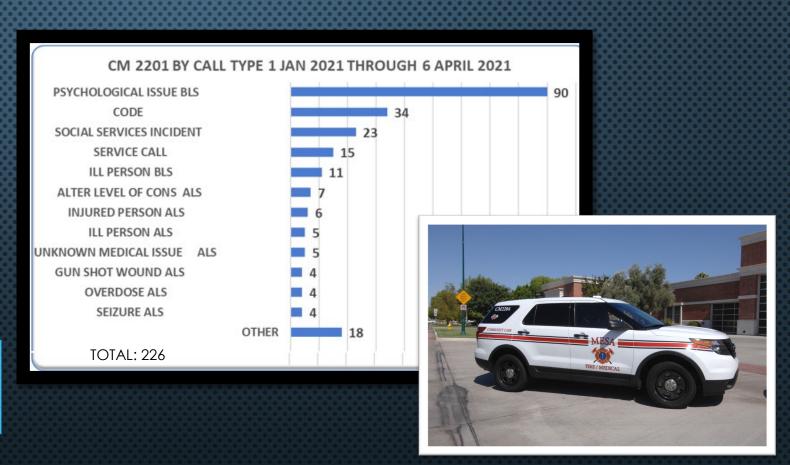
