Subject: Purchase of One PM-10 Compact Path Sweeper (Addition) for the Transportation Department **(Funded by the Environmental Compliance Fee) (Citywide)**

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Transportation Departments and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Sourcewell cooperative contract with Balar Equipment at \$227,847.92.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide one, RAVO 5-i Series Compact Sweeper that will primarily be used for maintaining Shared Use Pathways in the City of Mesa. The compact street sweeper is a more maneuverable sweeper better suited to the challenges of Shared Use Pathways sweeping. The small PM-10 sweeper can sweep in the presence of pedestrians, pets, cyclists, and other modes of transport on a pathway. A sweeper on Shared Use Pathways must also be able to operate in tunnels, low overhead areas, ADA ramps, and other narrow passageways.

The Sourcewell cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. Utilizing this cooperative contract provides very competitive rates based on a nationally solicited agreement. Fleet Services, Transportation and Purchasing believe that going out to bid for the vehicle would not result in the City receiving more favorable pricing or terms.

Additionally, the Sourcewell contract allows the City to purchase an in-stock RAVO compact sweeper deliverable upon payment rather than waiting the 16 to 24 months for order and production.
