| Subject: | Seven-Month Term Contract with Three Years of Renewal Options for Water, and Wastewater Industrial Plumbing Supplies for the Water Resources Department (Citywide) |

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Water Resources Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Best Plumbing Specialties Inc.; Browns Partsmaster Inc.; and Ferguson Enterprises Inc. at \$100,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide pipe, fittings, valves, backflow devices, and other related products and equipment for the City's Water and Wastewater treatment facilities.

The City solicitated Request for Bids No. 2021129 - Pipe, Fittings, Valves and Backflow Devices, and received no bid responses on 4/8/2021. Due to the volatility of the plastics and metals markets, potential vendors were not willing to bid and commit to pricing at this time. The State of Arizona cooperative contracts will allow the department to address current and future needs.

The State of Arizona cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meet the City's procurement requirements. Using this cooperative contract provides very competitive rates based on a nationally solicited agreement.
