Subject: Purchase of Audio/Visual Equipment (Replacement/Upgrade) for the Mesa Police Department **(Citywide)**

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Police Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Mohave Cooperative contract with Corporate Technology Solutions, at \$91,100, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

The Police Training Division is requesting to use Corporate Technology Solutions (CTS) for its audio/visual upgrades at the Mesa Public Safety Training Facility – Maltese Classroom and Multipurpose Classroom. CTS is already familiar with City buildings and has the necessary security clearance to perform work for Mesa PD.

CTS provided quotes for the AV equipment and installation, and for preventative maintenance and service. The Maltese Classroom upgrade cost is \$43,954.15, and the first-year preventative maintenance and service \$1,350, for a total of \$45,304.15. The Multipurpose Classroom upgrade cost is \$44,383.02, and the first-year preventative maintenance and service \$1,350, for a total of \$45,733.02. The combined total for both Classrooms is \$91,037.17.

The Mohave cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. Using this cooperative contract provides very competitive rates based on a nationally solicited agreement.
