Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Storm Drain Pump and Maintenance Repair for the Transportation and Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Departments **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

A committee representing Transportation and Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Departments and Purchasing evaluated responses. The evaluation committee recommends awarding the contract to the highest scored proposal from RediPump, LLC at \$700,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The Transportation and Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities (PRCF) Departments are responsible for performing maintenance, repairs, and emergency repairs on the pumps operating within the City. This vendor will provide pump maintenance used to support storm pump inspections, maintenance, and repairs along with a variety of pumps overseen by PRCF - Facilities Maintenance.

The City received two proposal responses of which both vendors met the minimum qualifications. The evaluation committee evaluated the proposal responses in accordance with the City's established policies and procedures and completed scoring of the responses against the scoring criteria in the solicitation. Award is recommended to the highest scored respondent.
