Subject:	Purchase of High Availability Data Storage (Replacement) for the Department of Innovation and Technology (Funded by the Department of Innovation and Technology Lifecycle Management Program) (Citywide)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Department of Innovation and Technology and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Mohave cooperative contract and the lowest quoted vendor, iT1 Source LLC, at \$218,196.44.

Background / Discussion

This purchase is part of the City's Lifecycle Management Program to replace aging hardware that has reached its end of life. The result of this purchase is a highly available storage platform that provides improved performance, lower operating costs, using less space and power while providing a platform that safeguards critical data and applications.

The Mohave cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. Using this cooperative contract provides very competitive rates based on a nationally solicited agreement.
