Subject:	One-Year Term Contract with Four Years of Renewal Options for Electric Utility Distribution Transformers for the Materials and Supply Warehouse (for the Energy Resources Department) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Business Services and Energy Resources Departments and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidders, Anixter, Inc. and Power Partners, LLC at \$1,070,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract establishes a multi-year supply contract for electric utility distribution transformers, which are required to provide electrical service to new and upgraded commercial and residential services, as well as routine life cycle replacement of depreciated units.
