**Subject:** Purchase of Replacement Seating for the Mesa Arts Center (Funded by the

Mesa Arts Center Restoration Fee) (District 4)

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Arts and Culture Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Sourcewell cooperative contract with Hussey Seating Company at \$11,170.28.

## **Background / Discussion**

Mesa Arts Center (MAC) has been replacing worn seating in the Ikeda Theater. In May 2021, MAC purchased 54, Clarin portable chairs (Premium Series/VIP) by Hussey Seating for \$24,655.06. Purchasing administratively approved the purchase using the same cooperative contract.

After the old seating was removed, MAC realized there is ample room for more VIP chairs. This purchase is for 24 additional chairs of the same product. It will be the second purchase since May and the two purchases total \$35,825.34.

The Sourcewell cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. The cooperative contract provides the City better pricing by volume purchases and has been vetted by Purchasing for due diligence. Sourcewell's price for the Clarin Portable Chair is 43% off from the list price. MAC and Purchasing staff believe that going out for a formal bid would only delay the project and would not result in any cost savings to the City.
