Subject:	One-Year Term Contract for Dynamo Playground and Park Equipment Custom Replacement Parts and Repairs for the Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (Sole Source) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the sole source vendor, Dynamo Industries at \$300,000, based on estimated quantities.

Background / Discussion

Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department has seven parks that have custom-built, proprietary playground equipment provided by Dynamo Industries, including the Genesis and the Big Green Climber at Riverview Park and the Orange Monster at Eastmark. This contract will provide parts, repairs and add-on equipment for Dynamo playground and park equipment.

There is unrepairable damage to the spiral slides on the north structure of the Orange Monster and the spiral slides themselves are obsolete and unreplaceable. PRCF has opted to remove the damaged slides and replace them with barrier panels.

The Big Green Climber was damaged recently in a traffic accident. The City is still obtaining the repair/replacement cost, but this contract is intended to make that purchase as well. Reimbursement will be pursued through insurance.

Dynamo Industries is the sole source for repair and replacement parts for all Dynamo playground equipment.
