

COUNCIL MINUTES

June 7, 2021

The City Council of the City of Mesa met in a Special Council Meeting via a virtual format streamed into the Council Chambers, 57 East 1st Street, on June 7, 2021, at 6:23 p.m.

Mayor Giles conducted a roll call.

- 1. Conduct a public hearing on the proposed Fiscal Year 2021-22 Budget and the proposed Fiscal Year 2021-22 Secondary Property Tax Levy and take action on the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Budget.
 - 1-a. A public hearing on the proposed Fiscal Year 2021-22 Budget and the proposed Fiscal Year 2021-22 Secondary Property Tax Levy.

Mayor Giles announced that this was the time and place for a public hearing regarding the proposed Fiscal Year 2021-22 Budget and the proposed Fiscal Year 2021-22 Secondary Property Tax Levy.

There being no citizens present wishing to speak on this issue, the Mayor declared the public hearing closed.

1-b. A resolution approving the budget for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022. – Resolution No. 11690

City Manager Christopher Brady reported there would be an increase to the Mesa Secondary Property Tax due to the approval of the Transportation Bond. He stated originally the increase was \$28, but because of favorable interest rates and the growth within the City of Mesa, the increase for the average homeowner will be \$10 per year.

Mayor Giles reiterated that the Mesa voters passed a \$100,000,000 Transportation Street Bond funded by the Secondary Property Tax, which will increase the Tax Levy. It was moved by Councilmember Freeman, seconded by Councilmember Thompson, that Resolution No. 11690 be adopted.

Upon tabulation of votes, it showed:

Mayor Giles declared the motion carried unanimously and Resolution No. 11690 adopted.
