The Minnesota Multistate Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy (MMCAP) cooperative agreement provides vaccines and other pharmaceuticals including, Influenza, Tuberculin skin tests, Pertussis (Tdap), Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR), Varicella, Hepatitis B and Hepatitis A.</p> <p>The Mesa Fire and Medical Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Minnesota MMCAP cooperative contract with multiple vendors: GlaxoSmithKline, LLC; McKesson Corporation, dba, Sky Packaging; Merck Sharp &amp; Dohme Corp.; and Sanofi Pasteur, Inc., at \$110,000 annually, based on estimated usage. This purchase is \$100,000 funded by the Salt River Pima - Maricopa Indian Community Grant and \$10,000 from the AZDHS Grant.</p>
