The requested dollar-limit increase is to provide for the anticipated growth in the upcoming year and for the increased Index. The contracts cover all solid waste disposal, recyclable material processing, and vegetative waste processing services.</p> <p>The Environmental Management and Sustainability Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing contract amendments reflecting a dollar-limit increase of \$220,000 to the multi-vendor master agreement, from \$9,430,000 to \$9,650,000, based on the estimated usage with annual Consumer Price Index increase.</p>
