Mesa will be responsible for the rehabilitation cost of the Mesa-owned segment, at \$200,006.93, and the cost sharing allocation of the jointly owned segment, according to the percentages established in the 1979 IGA, at \$1,722,654.71, for a total estimated cost to Mesa, at \$1,922,661.64.
