(Citywide)</p> <p>Under this Agreement, \$300,000 is awarded to the following City of Mesa programs: Fire and Medical Department, Immunization Program (\$100,000); Water Resources Department, Hydration Stations (\$10,000); City Manager's Office, Special Projects - Downtown Business Improvements Signage (\$100,000), Mesa K-Ready, Kindergarten Readiness Program (\$40,000); and Arts and Cultural Department, Mesa Arts Center, Arts in Service (\$50,000).</p> <p>The balance of the funds will be distributed to other local community agencies as pass-through grants.</p>
