Approving and authorizing the City Manager to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Salt River Pima Maricopa Indian Community for the receipt and distribution of \$765,000 in Proposition 202 Funds. **(Citywide)**

Under this Agreement, \$300,000 is awarded to the following City of Mesa programs: Fire and Medical Department, Immunization Program (\$100,000); Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department, Positive Play (\$29,500); City Manager's Office, Social Media Community Engagement - City Activities (\$25,000), Mesa K-Ready, Kindergarten Readiness Program (\$42,500); Arts and Cultural Department, Mesa Arts Center, Arts in Service (\$53,000), and i.d.e.a. Museum, Barriers to Access (\$50,000).

The balance of the funds will be distributed to other local community agencies, including American Red Cross of Greater Phoenix, Salvation Army-Phoenix Family Services, Paz De Cristo, Feeding Matters, St. Mary's Food Bank, and United Food Bank as pass-through grants.
